TONIGHT'S GAME: The Iowa Cubs and Memphis Redbirds meet for the final four games of the regular season. The Cubs and Redbirds, Triple-A affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals, are tied for first place in the American Northern Division.

CUBS FALL BY 10: Despite scoring first, the Cubs fell to the Albuquerque Isotopes 13-3 last night. The loss dropped the Cubs to 80-60. The Isotopes rallied for four runs in the fifth inning to take a 5-2 lead before notching five runs in the eighth to claim the victory. Iowa was out-hit 19-7 Thursday night.

DIGGING THE LONGBALL: Brad Snyder hit a solo home run in the first inning last night. It was his 24th longball of the season, matching the team high (with Bryan LaHair). Snyder's 102 RBI rank second in the league this season. Jason Dubois hit a pair of three-run homers Wednesday night and set a season-high with six RBI. It was his second multi-homer game of this series and the fourth by a Cub in this set. Six different Cubs have a multi-homer game this season for a total of 12. Dubois has 86 home runs in 347 games over parts of five seasons with Iowa. He ranks second on the franchise career home runs list. The record is 90. His 263 career RBI with Iowa ranks third behind Micah Hoffpauir (378) and Joe Hicks (281).

ROAD WARRIORS: The Cubs have the league's best road record at 43-29. With Wednesday night's win, the Cubs tied the franchise record for road victories in a season. The Cubs finished 43-29 in 1993 to set the record.

STREAK STOPPED: Bryan LaHair's eight game hit streak ended last night. During the streak, he batted .421 (24-for-57) with two doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI, and 12 runs scored.

A BIG "WHAT-IF?": To win the division, Iowa needs to take three-of-four games from Memphis. If Omaha, who is currently in third place but only two games back, wins their remaining schedule and Iowa and Memphis split, there would be a three-way tie for first place. In this scenario, Omaha would make the playoffs because they have the best division record (25-23) over Memphis (24-24).

VS. MEMPHIS: The Cubs and Memphis head into this final four-game series tied with an 80-60 record in the Pacific Coast League. The head-to-head is also tied at 6-6 between these clubs. Iowa holds the advantage at Principal Park, 3-1, this season. Memphis leads the All-time series 87-84.

PENNANT CHASE: The Cubs are tied for the PCL's best record at 80-60. With four games left in the regular season, the Cubs are tied with Memphis in the PCL American Northern Division. The Redbirds are 9-1 in their last 10 games. The Cubs have had at least a share of the division lead for the last 46 days. Today is the first day since July 19 that the Cubs have not had sole possession of first place.

STREAKING: Bobby Scales has hit safely in a season-high 11 straight games. During this streak, he is batting .350 (14-for-40) with eight runs, four doubles, a home run, and seven RBI while raising his average 12 points from .253 to .265. Jason Dubois has hit safely in nine straight games and has scored a run in eight straight. During this streak, he is batting .425 (17-for-40) with six home runs, a triple, 14 RBI, and 11 runs scored. Marquez Smith has hit safely in five straight games and 10 of 11. He is batting .429 (9-for-21) with a double, three homers, 10 runs scored, and 11 RBI in his last five games. Brad Snyder has hit safely in five straight and nine of 11. He is batting .391 (18-for-46) with six doubles, four home runs, 13 runs scored, and 13 RBI in his last 10 games.

RYNO GETS TOP HONOR: Iowa Cubs Manager Ryne Sandberg was today named Pacific Coast League Manager of the Year. Sandberg is in his fourth season managing in the Cubs organization. One year ago, he guided the Double-A Smokies to a second-half division title, taking the club to the Southern League Championship Series. The PCL post-season awards are given based on the voting of the league's field managers, general managers, broadcasters and media. Pat Listach won the award with Iowa in 2008.

RH **Chris Carpenter** will make his third start for the I-Cubs today. He made his Triple-A debut August 24 in the series finale against Nashville. In his last outing at Omaha on August 29, he threw six innings, allowing nine hits and four runs. He did not figure in the decision of the game. Iowa won the game, 8-7.

ON THE DOUBLE: Carpenter joined the I-Cubs on August 22nd from Double-A Tennessee and joined the starting rotation in place of the injured **J.R. Mathes**. Carpenter was 8-6 with a 3.16 ERA in 23 starts for the Smokies. In 119.2 innings, he allowed 118 hits, walked 48, and struck out 100. He left the Smokies ranked sixth in the Southern League in ERA.

ERA CHAMP: Last year, Carpenter made three stops in Cubs' organization and reached double-A in his first full year of pro ball. He started with single-A Peoria in the Midwest League and went 4-3 with a 2.44 ERA in 15 starts while earning a spot on the mid-season All-Star Team. He also made five starts with Daytona in the Florida State League and seven starts with Tennessee. His 2.82 ERA over three levels led all Cubs' minor league pitchers.

THE COLLEGE YEARS: The Cubs selected Carpenter in the third round of the 2008 June Free Agent Draft out of Kent State University. In 2008, he was named the Mid-American Conference Pitcher of the Year and First Team All-MAC. Carpenter was 6-2 with a 3.81 ERA in 13 games and led the conference with 88 strikeouts in 76 innings.

vs. MEMPHIS: Today will be Carpenter's first career appearance against the Redbirds.
